Principal's Report

- Gym classes are just starting to get going. Extra-curricular sports are still getting sorted out.
- Start times don't need to be staggered because of multiple entrances, the school acknowledges that kids are going to mingle outside of school no matter what the rules. Each cohort has their own entrance.
- Water bottle/fountains are open again.
- About two kids per day are going home due to illness, parents are requested to come quickly. Staff will wait with the student outside until a parent arrives.
- Field trips can still happen as long as it's within the cohort.
