- PAC Executive would like to save approximately \$5,000 from Gaming account in case gaming funds are decreased next year due to COVID.
- PAC has been asked to fund division ball bags

- On Monday, October 5th a Grade 7 boy from Colquitz passed away. This is the first exposure to death for a lot of students. District response team consisting of four SD 61 staff were sent to guide the school though the process. They remain available if needed.
