- 15 years studying salish art. 2D (paintings, prints), last few years 3D (wood, stone, steel, glass, jewellry)
- Salish Stone carving died out about 500 years ago, hopes to revive it. Has one student currently. Enjoys teaching and giving back to the community
- Short slide-show of some of his work was given to attendees in relation to PAC funds committed in 2020 for a piece commissioned for the Colquitz main entrance
