# 6. Items for Discussion

- Update on PAC commitment letter of support for restoring Police Liaison program
  - Example: School Liaison Officer would come in to talk to grade 8 students on social media, etc
    <u>Human Rights Commissioner sent a letter</u> to the B.C. School Boards (district employers) to advise that program should be discontinued "unless and until they can demonstrate an evidence-based need for them that cannot be met through other services". This resulted in a decision from the Victoria and other School Boards to remove the program. <u>Vancouver's Board has since restored the program</u>.
  - o Parent Survey completed in 2021 have asked for survey results
  - The PAC is working towards a letter of support that was requested by outgoing principal and may include parent input using the FB page survey tool

- Gaming Grant process for 2023/24 school year
  - o Examples are: chicken coop, pancake breakfast, grade 8 celebration, gaga ball court
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Teachers put an submission for field trips or other items
  - o Once submissions come in, PAC will review and make a decision
- Multi-School Parent Education Night at Spectrum early November
