- Popcorn Sales Update
 - So far the second round of popcorn sales has made \$62.25 profit
 - Have covered the cost of the second order (\$456.75)
 - o 127 bags left that will be 100% profit (\$3/bag)
 - Band kids are helping
 - Will need to order more to continue the sales until spring break
 - Could sell any leftovers at music concert
 - Five bags are unaccounted for from the first order (\$7.60 approx loss)
 - Typical part of doing business is some loss, CPAPA needs to determine acceptable amount
 - To minimize losses/mistakes, Angle is creating a popcorn procedurals document and is storing the popcorn in the band room to reduce confusion of moving large amounts of popcorn bags
