
Hello Colquitz Families,

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The Salmon People Spirit Wear is back!

We are excited to be offering to the Colquitz community "The Salmon People" by Qwul'thilum (Dylan Thomas). Dylan is a Victoria-born Coast Salish artist from the Lyackson First Nation, who was commissioned by Colquitz PAC to create an art piece that reflected and celebrated our connection to our lands, and more specifically, the Colquitz River. The result is a spectacular circular cedar carving in the style of a spindle whorl, depicting the important intercon-
