December Parent Education focuses on Experimenting with Substance:

Now What? A beginning conversation for families when our kids begin experimenting with substances.

Learning that our kids are trying substances can be scary. As families, we are a valuable resource to help them navigate the choices they are making, but it can be hard to know how to respond. This video introduces parents and caregivers to some ways that can help us move from reacting to our fears about substance use and towards a more thoughtful response that supports connection with our kids.
